Altamont native and professional racing announcer Kurt Becker will share his thoughts on how lessons learned from the world of racing can help maximize potential in the local community. Becker's announcing career spans nearly 20 years, including stints at Churchill Downs, Arlington Race Track and Keeneland Racecourse on the horse racing circuit and Nascar's MRN Radio and Barrett-Jackson Collector Car events. Becker made Keeneland history in 1997 as the first live announcer of a race in the track's 60+ years history. A graduate of Altamont High School and Southern Illinois University-Carbondale, Becker remains actively involved in the Altamont community, serving as president of the Altamont Library Board of Trustees and secretary of Bethlehem Lutheran Church's 2011 Sesquicentennial Committee.
